



CCS (2): 16 categories of vocabulary

CCS (3)

- Systematic structure and layout
 - Items logically organised within categories (people, places, body etc)
 - Then subcategorised into topics (people home, school, public workers, church, club, relations, pronouns, generic people etc);
- Predictable vocab organisation facilitates learning and ease of access
- Designed to be accessed using auditory scanning:
 communication partner reads out the list of categories for the user
 to indicate their choice (verbally, by nodding their head or using
 an agreed eye movement etc
