

How to find the Mary Marlborough Centre

By Road...

The Mary Marlborough Centre is situated in Headington, which is east of the City Centre, just inside the Oxford Ring Road. If approaching from the North, West or South, follow the signs along the Ring Road to Headington. At the A40/A4142 Ring Road roundabout, head west into the City Centre for about half a mile. You will reach a large number of shops at the top of a hill. At the traffic lights here, turn left into Windmill Road. A quarter of a mile down this road, turn right into the entrance of the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre. The Mary Marlborough Centre building can be seen immediately on the right after a small car park. If you are a car user, follow the signs to the Pay and Display car park (£2 for four hours) further into the hospital grounds.

By Train & Bus...

Journey time from London Paddington (usually a direct service) is approximately one hour. Taxis are available outside Oxford Station or you can catch a bus (number 22, also from the station) to Headington - ask for the Headington Post Office stop.

By Coach...

Frequent services run from London Victoria coach station (Oxford CityLink or Oxford Tube), Heathrow and Gatwick airports. Ask for the Central Headington stop (shown on the map).

Park & Ride

As there are a limited number of Pay & Display spaces within the grounds of the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre, an alternative option is the blue "Hospital Park & Ride" bus service, which runs from Thornhill Park & Ride just outside the Ring Road (see map) and goes right through the Nuffield Orthopaedic Centre (ask for the Mary Marlborough Centre stop. Allow an extra 20 minutes for this option.
